DISTRIBUTION:

Each week, large shareholders will choose 7-8 items from the week's distribution harvest. Small share members will choose 4-5 items. Set-up will be farm stand style. Some items will be limited, while others will be abundant depending upon the week and the weather. When in season, fruit items such as cantaloupe and watermelon will also be included in the share.

PYO flowers will become available as they reach maturity at our West Newbury field on Bridge St. All shareholders are invited to enjoy picking the flowers in the designated pick-your-own area. PYO start date will be posted at pick-up site.

A few examples of what constitutes an item: 1 lb. mixed greens, 1 bunch of carrots, 1.5 lbs. tomatoes etc.
Items will vary from week to week depending upon which vegetables or herbs are in season.

Share pick-up is weekly (Fridays 3pm-7pm) at the First Parish Church of Newbury, 20 High Rd., Newbury, MA.

CSA is a form of local agriculture designed to directly connect consumers to growers. Consumers (shareholders) commit to supporting farms and growers by sharing the costs of produce production, along with the accompanying risks (weather, pests, etc.) and rewards. Growers commit to providing shareholders with organically grown produce throughout the CSA season. The result is a food supply grown sustainably, without the use of chemicals, herbicides, or pesticides.

We are a multi-farm collaborative CSA program comprised of growers in Newbury, West Newbury, and Central Massachusetts. All items are certified organic. Fruits not grown by us and other add-on items offered to shareholders may be organically grown (though not certified) and will be appropriately labeled as such.
